ONE PLANET

Over time, this erodes faith in truthfulness, altruism, and collective responsibility, making such ideals seem naïve or unattainable.

This tension is not just societal; it's deeply personal. Every leader faces this decline in trusted authority. Yet true leadership requires engaging with this dilemma, not avoiding it. One Planet Leadership calls for confrontiny the contradiction, working toward its resolution, and leading with integrity.

The challenge is clear: can we confront the reality of our limits, acknowledge the allure of denial, and demand leadership grounded in courage and honesty?

Your leadership must move beyond comforting illusions, embracing resilience and a willingness to grapple with hard truths. It must succeed in meeting today's challenges while contributing to systemic change—advancing circular economies, reducing resource consumption, and empowering communities.

You must cultivate new narratives that celebrate diversity, balance, and sufficiency, replacing fantasies of endless expansion with inspiring stories of living well within the Earth's limits. By embracing this complex reality, you can guide your enterprise effectively while contributing to a sustainable, equitable future. PROGRAMS

Our One Planet Leadership Programs aim to support people who want to understand more about taking a lead to improve their companies, communities, societies - and careers; and to do this in the midst of intensifying crises around the world.

RoundTables for Experienced Managers

Focuses on the current challenges faced by **people in positions of authority and responsibility,** all round the world. We offer this in person and online.

2 Facilitator Track

To train and support **professional consultants, facilitators and organisers** who might want to develop and apply this approach in their own contexts.

What is One Planet Leadership and what difference can it make to you?

One Planet Leadership is concerned with the profound relations amongst people and between humans and Nature, and how to make these more fruitful through our working lives. It recognises connections and interdependencies between ecology and economy, and between personal motives, organisational purpose and wider society.

Businesses face ever greater tensions between serving their immediate stakeholders (investors, customers, employees) and the wider publics likely to be affected by their company's activities – including as-yet unborn generations and distant eco-systems. What should leaders be responsible for? The actual priorities for any particular organisation are often conflicted and more a matter of judgement than calculation.

International NGOs and public organisations face parallel dilemmas: Polarising tendencies in global politics can drive a wedge through inclusiveness; localisation, mistrust of institutions and technical experts challenge established hierarchies. Who has legitimate authority, and who will be held accountable to stakeholders with different interests? All this puts greater emphasis on listening, understanding and wise responsiveness.

These programs provide the opportunity to develop worldly-wise perspectives and peer-to-peer relationships: qualities that will be crucial for many careers and certainly for sustainability transitions by businesses and governments.


Participants and faculty on these programs collaborate in structured processes of reflection, analysis and friendly consulting.

The programs are in 4 parts:

- 1. The purpose and nature of managing and leading in complex situations.
- 2. Looking at how leadership is accomplished in a number of other organisations and cultures., and emerging responses to new opportunities and challenges.
- 3. Application to your own circumstances.
- 4. Options for responsible leadership by citizens in different parts of the world.

A Collaborative Program

The program described here is supported by a Consortium of organisations committed to a 3-5 year involvement so that we can develop and refine the experience with those involved. This also helps us to contribute to issues of current importance.

The Consortium consists of business and engineering schools at leading universities, large employing organisations and forward-thinking OD and LD consulting companies.

Consortium partnership is by arrangement with the organisers to ensure a multi-national spread of participants. Partners commit to 3-5 years and to send between 5 and 15 people each year. They pay a small annual partnership fee.

Per-person participation fees are set at a level to enable people to engage from a wide variety of economic circumstances. The on-line mode is considerably less costly than in-person.

Alongside the international multi-country versions of these programs, we support regional versions that are easier for shared time-zones and travel; and a sub-brand, Pelevation Programs, that supports design and delivery in languages other than English - Japanese, for example.

Partner Schools

Our partner schools bring a diversity of cultures, languages and managerial challenges to the group, so that together we can explore how things get done in a cross-cultural world, and how to work more effectively.

Who it's for

The RoundTables is for people with significant managerial responsibility, whether in a formal line role or as an entrepreneur or campaign leader.

The Facilitator track is for faculty members and consultants who want to use these approaches in their own work.

Company visits

Participants will visit other businesses and learn how managers from other sectors and cultures approach the conundrums that are inherent to managerial responsibility. This context provides opportunities to compare and discuss the effects of major issues such as climate change, globalisation, trade barriers, national and international standards and regulations, gender relations and so forth. It also opens a window into the many ways in which authority becomes legitimate (or the opposite), and how the widespread desire for good leadership works out in different settings. Bringing all this together into useful, actionable insight - what you can do about it - is the focus for the consulting process that follows.

Accreditation and Certificates

The program is accredited at Masters level by several partner business schools, forming an elective module in EMBA and similar programs, including a professional PhD. As a stand-alone 'executive education' course, participants will be awarded a certificate of completion. We can help with integration into a curriculum or into an Exec Ed portfolio.

What participants will learn on these days:

The programs illuminate five managerial mindsets - reflective, analytic, worldly, collaborative and action-oriented. Bringing these into the scope of complex, fast-changing contexts will help you to make best use of your innate wisdom.

During the first two sections you will analyse the 'soft influencing' processes of management. The focus will be your own managerial and leadership work, and clarifying what 'good' looks and feels like. This will be an international, multicultural and multi-lingual group, so appreciating the 'differences that matter' is crucial for effective leadership. It will require a truly worldly mindset and you'll use methods you can immediately apply at work.

By the third section we will be ready to explore diverse business ecosystems. In the on-line program you will visit (virtually) the workplaces and meet colleagues of other class members - as they will visit your workplace and colleagues. (Preparation for this is part of the pre-course assignment). The inperson program includes actual visits to local companies. This is a unique opportunity to compare managerial cultures and to gain external perspectives on your workplace. The focus on realities of participants' managerial and leadership work is a unique, highly valued aspect of this programme.

In the fourth section- you will learn and deploy a dynamic, structured consulting method to re-frame your own managerial challenges. This will be one of several practical take-aways from the course.

In the fifth section we concentrate on purpose, leadership and communityship. Our individual working lives, the organisations we serve and the communities we belong to can really make a difference towards a better world. There's no preaching - but tough and important questions to address.


